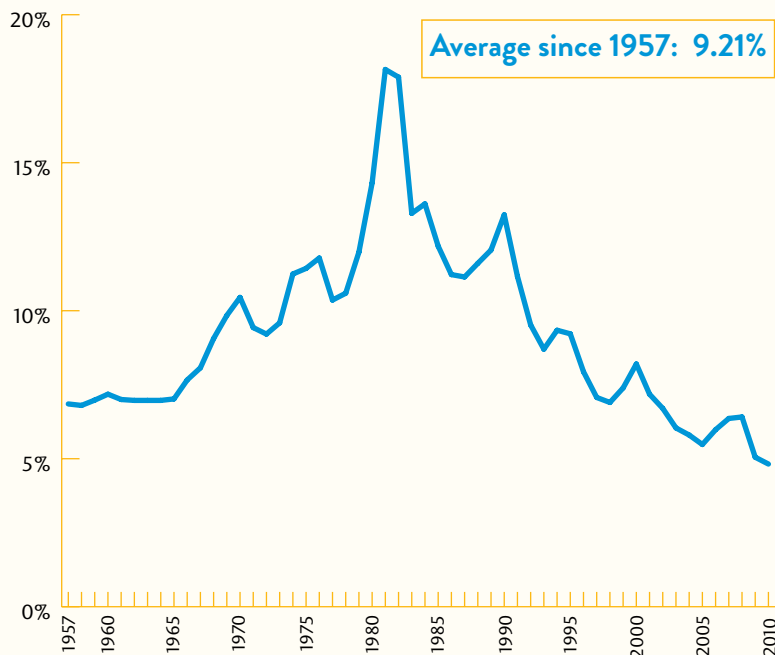




An historical review of 5-year fixed mortgage rates
